- Teacher evaluations completed over fall break
Parent portal is open rather than paper distributing evaluation sheets
- AZ Merit Overview
3rd through 5th grade; Over a period of 5 days; About 8 hours of total testing
Common Core and standardized test, written and on computer
An assessment of where students stand, educationally, amongst peers
Great Hearts currently holds a strong, successful curriculum and considers AZ Merit as a suggestion in curriculum changes
 - Great Hearts is data informed, not data driven
 - Changes can't be made that are "harmful", i.e. A five paragraph essay in 3rd grade is not seen as a necessary standard
 - Core knowledge, Singapore math, Spaulding are not 100% on AZ Merit but help students learn through Great Hearts mission and moral training
 - Part of Archway Veritas funding does depend on results of test
 - Prep side opted out of AZ Merit and chose SAT. Veritas may change 2019-2020Typing Master for AZ Merit
 - Used in 3rd through 5th grades
 - Helps prepare students for computer portion of AZ Merit
 - Login/info is available if interested in offering at homeParents may visit AZ Merit website to see what subjects are on test, as well as test results.

Great Hearts students, Private School students and Public School students are very balanced on enrollment percentages
