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These past two days teachers and students have focused on affectionate order through the development of habits of personal order. This is important work. This work cultivates habits of intellectual order. Our focus on the uniform aesthetic of ACV reflects our commitment to the same ideals and visually shows that it is indeed one community of learners. Yet, two days is not enough to solidify the foundation. Nor can teachers and students do this work alone. Your partnership completes the loop. Your support of our uniform policy is appreciated. As I shared at the headmaster coffee our efforts to align our students' exterior appearance with the uniform policy allows us to focus on what is most important – their interior formation.

Next week, grades $1^{st} - 5^{th}$ grades will more than likely be starting to assign homework. We believe that homework should play an important but limited part of a student's day. Homework serves many purposes. It helps to develop executive functioning skills such as time management and follow-through. It also allows students to process what they have learned at their own speed, and to engage in repeated retrieval which reinforces learning. Most importantly, it allows parents to connect with their students as their primary instructors.

We also understand that in developing the whole child, homework cannot compete with other good things like sports, playing an instrument, family time, unstructured play and sometimes sleep, which are also equally important to a child's development. With this in mind, teachers assign homework that they believe students can successfully complete independently and within a certain amount of uninterrupted time. Our approximate maximum time limits are:

Kindergarten- 20 minutes- only Reading and Spalding (not assigned quarter one) 1^{st} grade – 10 2^{nd} grade – 20 minutes 3^{rd} grade – 30 minutes 4^{th} grade – 40 minutes 5^{th} grade - 50 minutes

Time set aside for reading either independently or with a family member is also encouraged on a nightly basis.

Parents & Guardians - Please drop off your children using both lanes. For student safety, if you chose to walk your children to school, please remember that parents should not be crossing with their children onto the breezeway/playground area.

Students on campus prior to 7:45am that are not a Sunrise Club participant or VPA sibling will be brought into Sunrise Cub for campus safety. Families will be contacted by our Dean of Students, Mrs. Gandy and billed accordingly.

Archway students who have VPA siblings should enter through the VPA courtyard/cafeteria. Do not have your Archway students walk around the building and on the parking lot unaccompanied.

A Note from Mrs. Gandy

It has been so wonderful seeing all the students back on campus. I had the opportunity to go into all the classrooms this week. I saw smiling faces, a lot of participation in classrooms and students connecting with old and new friends on the playground. I wanted to remind Archway families about a few things before we begin our first full week. Your child's teacher will be reaching out if they have any uniform infractions that need to be corrected. We are asking families to have the correct items by Monday, August 15th. We

ask not only for the student's commitment to this concept, but for the parent/guardian's as well.

UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

Archway Veritas has a primary objective of developing a "community of learners," dedicated to the highest standards of academics and deportment. As such, a distinctive uniform is a unifying factor within the community. Please make sure your child is meeting the Uniform and Dress Code expectations.

***SHOES:** Solid white or solid black athletic shoes. The logo on the shoe must be the same color as the shoe. The sole may be a different color, but laces must also match the shoe. Students may not wear slip-ons or dress shoes. Please no rainbows, iridescent/glitter stripes, Converse, etc. Please see pages 39-43 of the Family Handbook for more details.

***SOCKS:** Socks should be solid white, navy, or black with NO logos. Boys may wear ankle socks only. Girls may wear ankle and knee-high socks. No crew or no-show socks please.

***HAIR ACCESSORIES:** Neat small bows, barrettes, headbands, and hair times are permissible so long as they coordinate with the uniform. (baby blue, navy, black, white, and gray are acceptable colors)

***MAKEUP/NAIL POLISH:** Students may not wear makeup of any kind. Students may not wear colored nail polish. Clear is acceptable.

***EARRINGS:** Girls may wear one small pair of studded earrings. No loops or dangling earrings are permitted. Boys may not wear earrings.

***TOYS/BALLS/SPORTS GLOVES:** Students may not bring these items from home to bring to recess.

Lead by Example

- Stay in designated pick up areas as directed by school personnel.
- Yield to pedestrians, crossing guards, and buses, and be aware that children who are walking/riding bikes may not look both ways before venturing in or across a roadway.
- For those walking or riding themselves to campus, please remind them to stay on designated pedestrian/bike routes, look both ways, and cross only at designated areas (do not walk/ride in between cars). Wait for crossing guards, and walk bikes, skateboards, etc., across school driveways.
- Put your phone down and keep your eyes forward.
- Speed on school campus is to be kept at or below 10 mph and drivers must operate their vehicles with due care and caution at all times.
- Be sure to drive the proper direction through parking lots and nearby streets.
- When waiting for students to be released, pull all the way forward on the curb to allow other cars ample room and minimize driving around.
- Make sure your child is fully buckled in before pulling away.

Parents should be patient, respectful, and courteous to other drivers while they pick their students up from school as well as the faculty and staff who are keeping students safe while on duty in the parking lots. Anger and frustration can lead to careless, unsafe behavior, and being a positive role model can help students learn safe procedures.

Obey ALL traffic laws

NO parking on the west side of 54th street (there are signs) Do not turn right into the main driveway from the middle lane off of 56th street Do not turn left when exiting the campus during drop off and pick up onto 56th street *Community Courtesy*

Do not block driveways of homes in the neighborhood Be sure to drive the proper direction through parking lots and nearby streets

Message from the Health Office

Water is essential! In our very hot and dry climate in Arizona, we need to be aware of how easily it is to become dehydrated. Please send your child *daily* with a reusable water bottle. Their water bottle can be refilled at any one of our rehydration stations. Apply sunscreen to any exposed areas before school.

We monitor the Maricopa County heat index very closely. Any time the temperatures exceed 90-105 degrees or above in conjunction with humidity levels, the heat advisory guidelines are put into effect which means limiting or canceling outdoor recess. Your students' safety is our number 1 priority!

Hearing and Vision Screening will be done the week of September 6th, on Kindergarten, First, Third, and Fifth graders. All new students will be tested as well.

Reminder for parents of Fifth Graders who will be turning 11, **Tdap** and **Meningococcal Vaccine** is required when the student turns 11. Please send in the records to the Health Office.



As always, students MUST stay home when they are sick.

If your child comes to school sick, they will be sent home. Our aim is to provide a safe campus for everyone.
