#### **New Student Orientation; 1st - 5th Grade**

New Student Orientation takes place Tuesday, August 6th from 4:00 - 4:20pm. All 1st - 5th grade new students are required to attend, along with at least one parent/guardian. Students will have time with administration to learn the ins and outs of what it means to be a Veritas student. Faculty will help students gain familiarity with the campus. During this

time, parents will get early access to the gymnasium to learn about social events and community building, sign up to volunteer, order yearbooks, and purchase spirit wear through the Archway Veritas Parent Service Organization (AVPSO) beginning at 4:00 pm. Families will be reunited at 4:20 and proceed to their classroom to meet their homeroom teacher, find their desks, and receive their textbooks before Back to School Night begins for returning families at 4:30 pm.



# **Back to School Night**

Back to School Night is Tuesday, August 6th from 4:30 - 6:30 pm. The evening is an open house format for students and families. We highly recommend that families allot 1 hour for the event. Families will enter through the gymnasium on the south side of the building beginning at 4:30 pm.

Families will have an opportunity to learn about social events and community building, sign up to volunteer, order yearbooks, and purchase used uniforms and spirit wear through the Archway Veritas Parent Service Organization (AVPSO).

Students will meet their homeroom teacher, find their desks, and receive their textbooks.

Parents received an email form their child's homeroom teacher on **Friday**, **August 2nd** to let you know which classroom your child is in. The school will not post rosters on the front doors of the school. Class maps will be available at the front desk.

Kona Ice will be onsite from 4:30-6:30 pm with treats to purchase.

# **Arizona State Guidelines**

Current/existing students who completed last school year at their academy and are returning to same academy for the new school year are considered pre-registered and are expected to be in attendance on the first day of school. According to A.R.S. 15-901(a)(2), students who do not meet attendance requirements will be withdrawn and must apply to the academy again to be considered for another possible offer of enrollment.

First day of school: Thursday, August 8th

#### First day of School

The first day of school, August 8th, <u>ALL families</u> may walk their children to their classroom if they wish.

Beginning Friday, August 9th, guardians will no longer be able to walk their child back to their classroom. Students should be dropped off in the designated drop-off lanes.

# **Drop off & Pick Up**

**Drop Off:** 7:45am is the earliest drop-off time for students. Faculty supervision will be available to *all* students on the playground and cafeteria beginning at 7:45am.

\*Students should never be dropped off prior to 7:45am except students enrolled in <u>Sunrise</u> <u>Club</u> @ 7:15am

OR

Veritas Prep siblings @ 7:30am.

Students who arrive at school after **8:14** am will need to be walked in by a guardian and signed in to receive a tardy pass. Students are not authorized to walk into the building unaccompanied after school has started. Families who fail to do so will be called to return to school to sign their child in.

If your child is going to be absent please call the school, 602-489-7341. You are welcome to email the teacher to advise them of their absence, please include the attendance email as well so we can enter it into the State Compliance System, <a href="mailto:attendance@archwayveritas.org">attendance@archwayveritas.org</a> and/or Mrs. O'Connor, <a href="mailto:moconnor@archwayveritas.org">moconnor@archwayveritas.org</a>.

**Pick Up:** Although the first few weeks may be more chaotic as we all resume our routines, please know that this too shall pass. Don't forget to use your family car placard when picking up. The car placards assist our faculty pick up helpers to safely and quickly get students into the family car. Students are dismissed at 1:30pm on Wednesdays, 12:00pm on Half-Days and 3:15pm on regular school days,

# **54th Street**

For the safety of our students and out of respect for our campus neighbors, vehicle pick-up on 54th Street is **prohibited**. Exit through the 54th street gate will be limited to **only** those students who walk/bike directly home and not to a parked car on 54th Street.

The safety and security of our community is of the utmost importance, and we appreciate your cooperation and understanding by following this campus-wide policy.

# **School Messenger Communication**

Great Hearts and Archway Veritas continue to utilize the system School Messenger for emails, robo-calls, and text messaging to inform families of campus related emergencies and other communications. School Messenger has a new automatic opt-in for text feature. During the registration/re-enrollment process families confirmed their wish to participate in text communications. Great Hearts will now automatically opt-in contact information given during the registration/re-enrollment process with the options you selected. You will notice at the beginning of July you will be opted in for text messaging. If you would like to opt-out of text messages simply reply STOP to block any text messaging. Please note, if opting-out, you will not receive texts regarding emergencies on campus.

## **Community Courtesy**

When teachers, students, staff and parents follow arrival/dismissal expectations, we all work together to keep everyone safe. School parking lots can be incredibly busy places in the morning when children arrive and in the afternoon during dismissal. Safety is a primary concern of the school staff, but it requires everyone's participation. Please model the virtues of patience and charity when entering and exiting the parking lot. **There is no more immediate way to show we are a true community**, and the stakes are high.

Here are some safety tips for safe arrival and dismissal:

- Do not arrive before 3:00 pm on regular dismissal days.
- Yield to pedestrians, crossing guards, and buses, and be aware that children who are walking/riding bikes may not look both ways before venturing in or across a roadway.
- For those walking or riding themselves to campus, please remind them to stay on designated pedestrian/bike routes, look both ways, and cross only at designated areas (do not walk/ride in between cars). Wait for crossing guards, and walk bikes, skateboards, etc., across school driveways.

- Speed on school campus is to be kept at or below 10 mph and drivers must operate their vehicles with due care and caution at all times.
- When waiting for students to be released, pull all the way forward on the curb to allow other cars ample room and minimize driving around.
- Make sure your child is fully buckled in before pulling away.
- Do not arrive before 3pm on regular dismissal days.

**Most important**, parents should be patient, respectful, and courteous to other drivers while they pick their students up from school as well as the faculty and staff who are keeping students safe while on duty in the parking lots. Anger and frustration can lead to careless, unsafe behavior, and being a positive role model can help students learn safe procedures.

\*There are so many great reasons to ride your bike: It offers fun, freedom and exercise, and it's good for the environment. Please be safe and remember to ensure your child is **wearing their helmet** when riding their bike.

Families that need to drop off their students prior to 7:45 am **must** sign-up for <u>Sunrise</u> <u>Club</u>.



## Message from the Health Office

**Water is essential!** In our very hot and dry climate in Arizona, we need to be aware of how easily it is to become dehydrated. Please send your child *daily* with a reusable water bottle. Their water bottle can be refilled at any one of our rehydration stations. Apply sunscreen to any exposed areas before school.

We monitor the Maricopa County heat index very closely. Any time the temperatures exceed 90-105 degrees or above in conjunction with humidity levels, the heat advisory guidelines are put into effect which means limiting or canceling outdoor recess. Your students' safety is our number 1 priority!

**Hearing and Vision Screening** will be done the week of September 9th, on Kindergarten, First, Third, and Fifth graders. All new students will be tested as well.

**Reminder** for parents of Fifth Graders who will be turning 11, **Tdap** and **Meningococcal Vaccine** is required when the student turns 11. Please send in the records to the Health Office.

If your child comes to school sick, they will be sent home. Our aim is to provide a safe campus for everyone.
