Have a conversation, ask questions, praise the success, and acknowledge the opportunity for growth. The conference can serve as a cornerstone for setting a new goal, striving for a greater intellectual or moral virtue, identifying which virtue could be an area of focus, or even establishing a fresh perspective on school for the remainder of the year.

Bring your school-approved garments and accessories from any prior academic event to swap for a future event, such as:

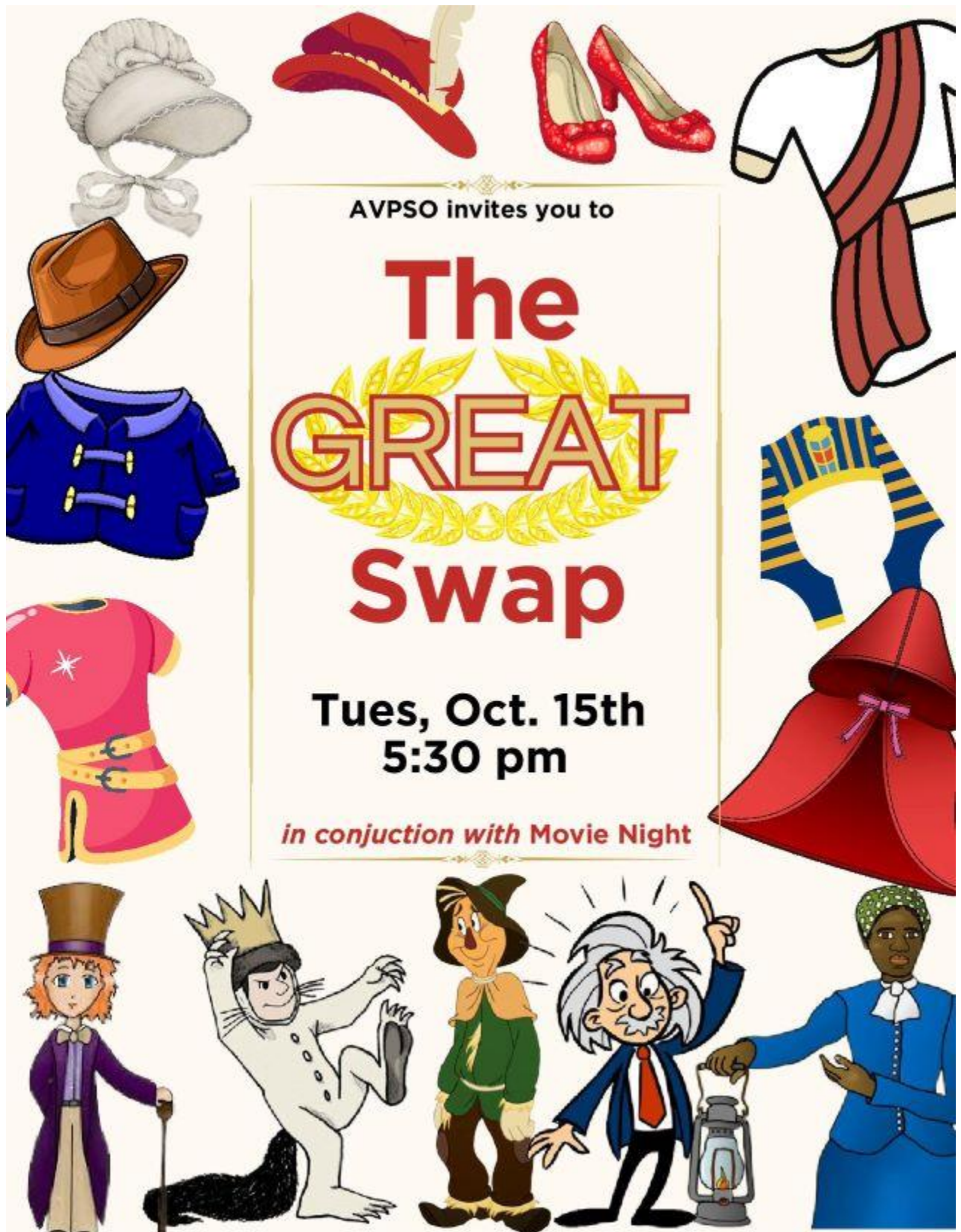

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### **Title I Annual Parent Meeting**

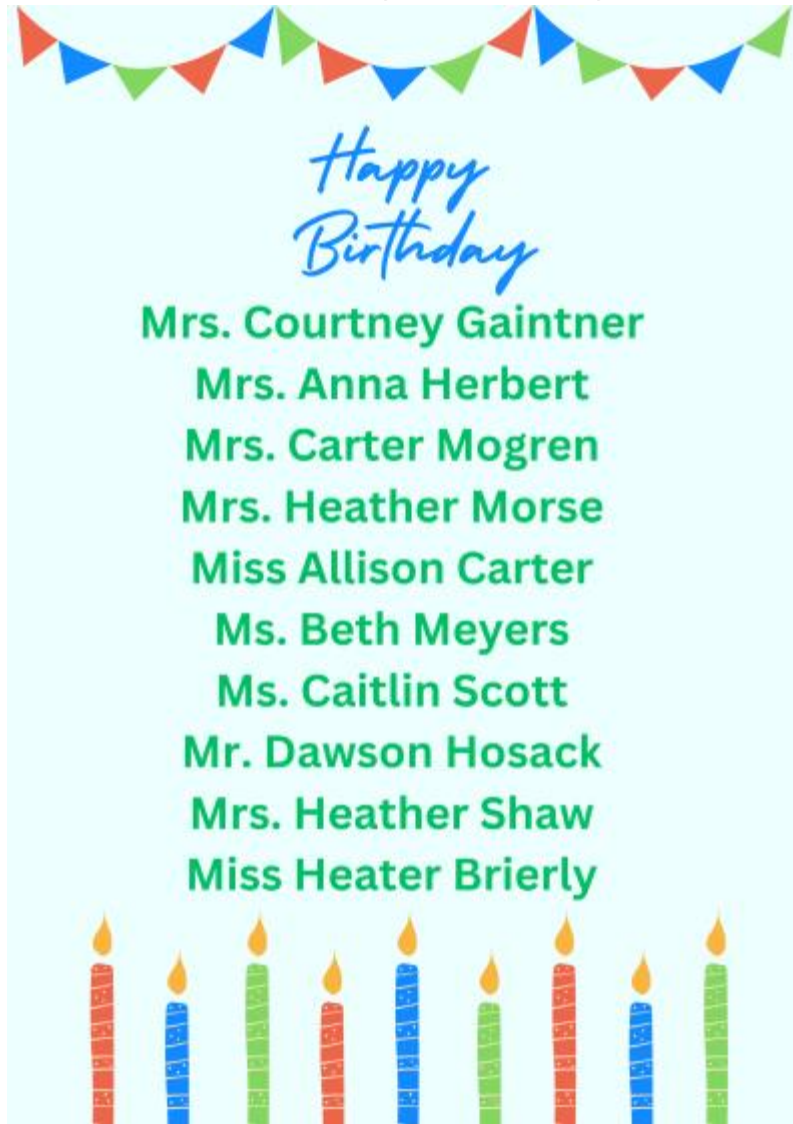
