Parent/Teacher conferences are held October 14th – 16th. Our conferences provide an opportunity for teachers and parents to reflect on our partnership in cultivating the *intellectual virtues* in our children. Conferences are not intended to focus on human excellence in terms of “delivering results” or merely academic performance. To do so would reduce human excellence to mere checklists and skills to be mastered.

Students do not attend conferences. However, I encourage you to share your conference experience with your child. Have a conversation, ask questions, praise the success, and acknowledge the opportunity for growth. The conference can serve as a cornerstone for setting a new goal, striving for a greater intellectual or moral virtue, identifying which virtue could be an area of focus, or even establishing a fresh perspective on school for the remainder of the year.

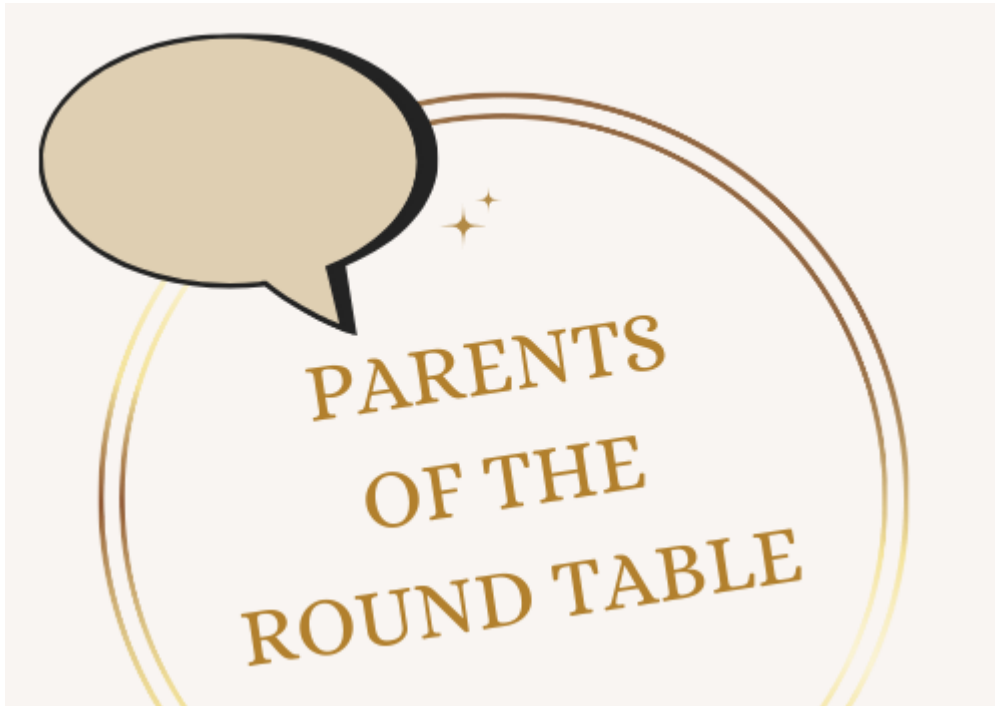

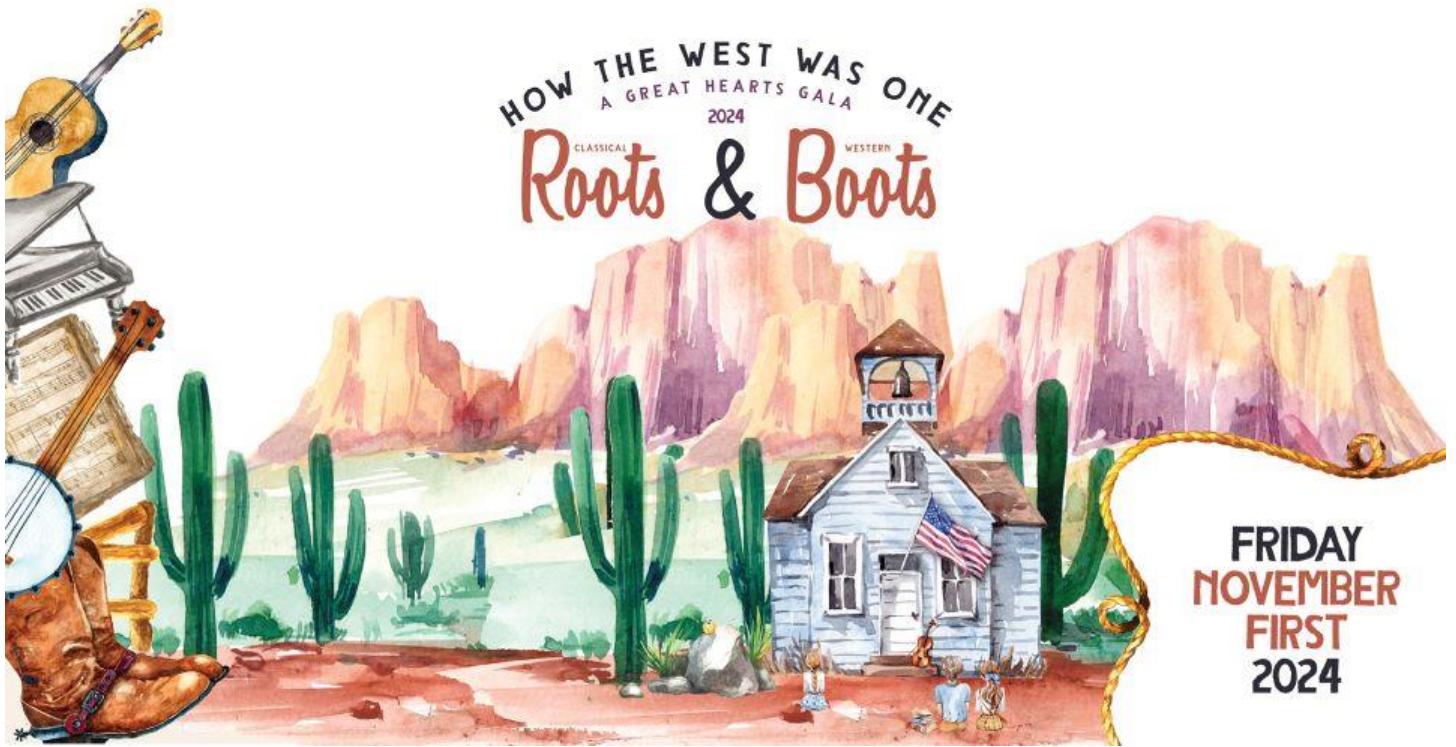

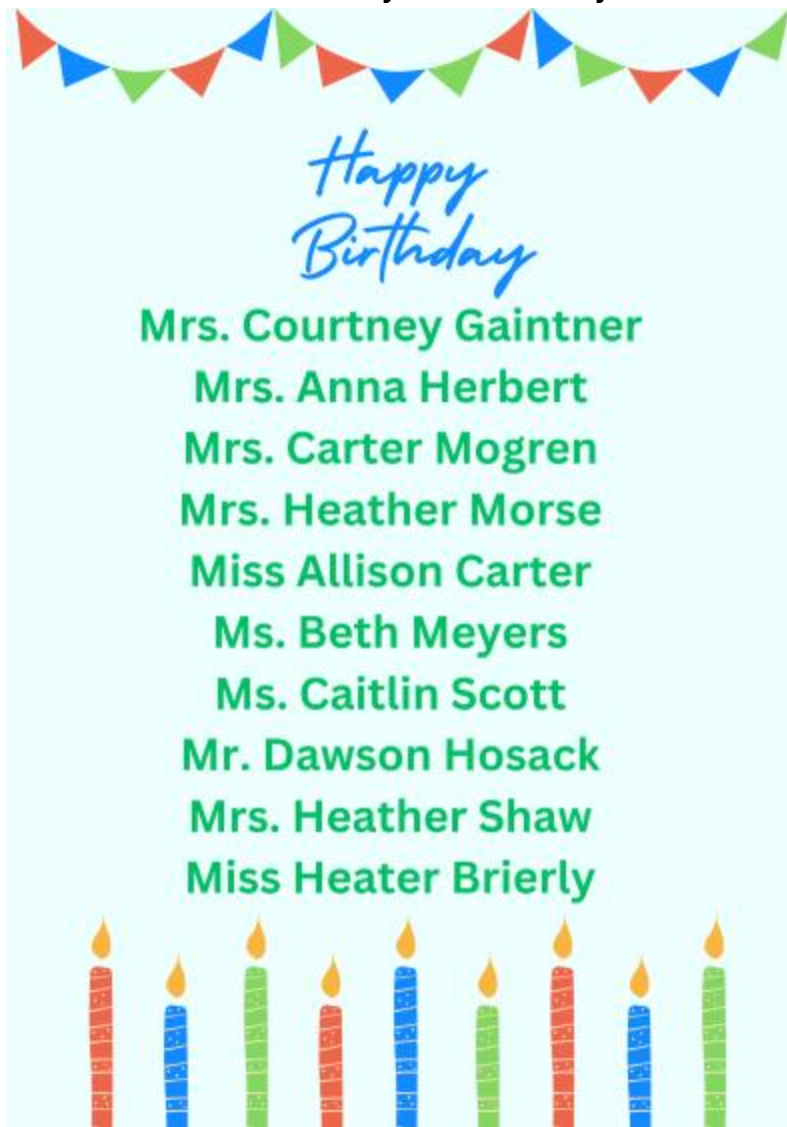
Title I Annual Parent Meeting
